RAMAN EXPERIENTIAL SCIENCE TEACHER AWARD

Teachers have among the strongest roles to play in society and – outside of family – they are usually our first adult role models. Many children perhaps spend more time with their teachers during their childhood than with their parents. We have instituted the REST Award to showcase the qualities, skills and strengths of science teachers

Any Teacher or Aspiring Teacher can participate in one of the three categories – Physics, Chemistry or Biology

WHAT AM I SUPPOSED TO DO?

Participants are expected to create hands-on science activities that demonstrate a principle in the selected topic. Working models, toys or experiments that help demonstrate the scientific principle selected may be submitted. The entries will be judged based on:

Originality of the idea

- Ease of access to materials required
- How well does it convey the science?
- Fun how eniovable is the activity?

The award is conducted in two stages and the first stage requires online registration and submission at www.ramanaward.org. Up to three submissions in any topic will be considered at the preliminary stage. The National Finals will be conducted at Sir C.V.Raman's old home at Bangalore

The Raman Awards will recognise schools that encourage the participation of Teachers and Students with commendation certificates. Teachers from Government Schools will be reimbursed second class train travel and lodging expenses. Other finalists are required to make their own arrangements.
